NOTICE OF RACE

The notation "[DP]" in a rule in the NoR means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing. (RRS)
- 1.2 No National prescription shall apply.
- 1.3 The class rules of the ICA and Contender Championships Rules 2018 Edition will apply.
- 1.4 Appendix P will apply.
- 1.5 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2 ADVERTISING

2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority, in accordance with World Sailing Regulation 20, as modified by the Advertising regulation of the FFVoile. [DP]

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to competitors with boats of the International Contender Class.
- 3.2 All competitors must be member of their National Authority and Country Contender Association at the time of registration.
- 3.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form, and sending the required fee, no later than 15th June 2019-via the official championships webpage www.contender-worlds-2019.com unless otherwise agreed by the organizing authority.

Late entries will be accepted after June 15th 2019, but the entries fees will be increased.

- 3.4 Competitors shall present during registration:
 - For competitors living in France, the valid and signed FFVoile licence with health certificate and a parents' permission for minors,
 - A valid authorization to display advertising on boat, if necessary,
 - Foreign competitors without a French licence shall present evidence of their membership to a WORLD SAILING Member national authority.
 - For all Crew: The measurement form of the boat, and a valid third-party liability insurance certificate with a minimum coverage of 2 000 000 Euros per event or the equivalent.

4 ENTRY FEES

- 4.1 The required competitor entry fee is 335 Euros.
- 4.2 Late entries after June 15th will be charged an entry fee of 370 Euros.
- 4.3 Entry fees should be paid by bank transfer to:

- 4.4 Late entry fees paid at registration shall be paid in cash in Euros.
- 4.5 Entry fee includes Regatta entry plus helmsman tickets to Welcome & Presentation functions, and event merchandise. The Championships dinner is included in the entry fee.
- 4.6 Pursuant to Rule 4.4 of the International Competition Championship Rules, the ICA will pay half the entry fee for Juniors under the age of 21 as of July 27 2019 and for overseas competitors under 25 years of age. The mechanism for this is the competitor will pay the total registration fee and may apply to his National Association for a refund of the amount paid.
- 4.7 Refund policy: In the event that a competitor has to renounce participation for valid reasons, the registration fee will be refunded.

5 FORMAT

The maximum number of boats racing in one fleet is 120. If the number of participants exceeds 120, the regatta may consist of a qualifying series and a final series. The heat management format is described in the Contender Championship Rules 2018 Edition "Addendum B: Qualifying Series – 3 day Qualifying Series, 2 races per day, Fleet assignment and race management."

6 SCHEDULE

6.1 Ten races are scheduled for the Championships.

- 6.2 Two races are scheduled for each racing day. One or more extra races per day may be sailed if necessary.
- 6.3 On the last day of the World Championships, no warning signal will be done after 15:00.

7 MEASUREMENT

- 7.1 All boats shall be presented for measurement.
- 7.2 A measurement certificate shall be provided at measurement. Weights in the boat shall be as specified in measurement certificate.
- 7.3 Each competitor shall present the following equipment to be measured and marked for the championship:
 - a) One only mast, boom and centerboard
 - b) No more than two rudders.
 - c) No more than two sails.
 - d) A tow floating rope of minimum length of fifteen (15) meters and with diameter of eight (8) millimeters capable of towing several boats shall be kept on board at all times.
- 7.4 Measurement checks and inspections may be carried out at any time. A boat notified of inspection shall follow the instructions of the Technical Committee.

8 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions addendum will be available at registration from 09.00 on Saturday 20thJuly 2019.

9 VENUE

The Racing Area will be the waters of Quiberon Bay off the Ecole Nationale de Voile et des Sports Nautiques (ENVSN).

10 **COURSES**

A windward leeward Triangular Courses will be as described in INTERNATIONAL CONTENDER CHAMPIONSHIP RULES 2018 and the sailing instructions.

11 **PENALTY SYSTEM**

An International Jury will be appointed in accordance with RRS, Appendix N. The International Jury decisions will be final as provided by RRS 70.5.

12 **SCORING SYSTEM**

- 12.1 A minimum of four (4) races must be completed to award the World Championships title.
- 12.2 The scoring system will be detailed in the sailing instructions.

13 COACHES AND SUPPORT BOATS [DP]

- 13.1 Team managers, Coaches and other support personal shall keep 100 m clear of the course area during racing, except when asked to assist by the Race Committee.
- 13.2 Maximum 2 people are allowed on the motorboat.
- 13.3 All support boats shall clearly display the three letter national code of their World Sailing Member National Authority at all times while afloat. The minimum height for the letters shall be 200 mm and visible from both sides of the boat.

14 RADIO COMMUNICATION [DP]

14.1 Except in case of an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make any voice or data transmission and shall not receive any voice or data transmission that is not available to all boats.

15 **PRIZES**

Prizes in the World Championships will be awarded as follows:

- 15.1 The World Champion will be the winner of the series and will obtain a gold medal, the second and third placed helmsmen will obtain a silver and bronze medal, respectively. If a qualifying series and a final series are completed, prizes will also be awarded to the three highest ranked helmsmen in the silver fleet.
- 15.2 The following prizes will also be awarded:
 - The Female World Champion will be the first female overall of the Championships.
 - The Junior World Champion will be the first overall under the age of 21 on the date of the first scheduled race of the Championships;
 - The Master World Champion will be the first overall aged 50 year old or more on the date of the first scheduled race of the Championships;
 - The Grand Master World Champion will be the first overall aged 60 year old or more on the date of the first scheduled race of the Championships.

In each of these categories, the second and third will also be rewarded.

16 **DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the event entirely at their own risk, see RRS 4 - Decision to Race.

The organizing authority or any of their officials or representatives or the sponsors or their officials or representatives will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the event.

17 **INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of 2 000 000 Euros per event or the equivalent.

18 RIGHT TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

In registering for the event, competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority the right in perpetuity to make, use and show from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproduction of them, taken during the period of the event, for the said event as defined in the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions in which he/she participates without compensation.

19 PLASTIC BANNING [DP]

As part of the policy of banning plastic waste recommended by the FFVoile, all plastic objects such as bottles, bags, food packaging, etc. must be secured to the boat.

A competitor who contravenes this objective of "Zero plastic discarded at sea" will be invited by the Jury to make a payment of the amount of his choice to the *Société Nationale de Sauvetage en Mer* (i.e. National Lifeboat Association). An urn will be deposited for this purpose at the Regatta Office.
